



Paw Performance® Heelwork to Music Training Show

Sunday 5th April 2020
at Whittington Pavillion, Park Hall, Oswestry Show Ground, SY11 4AS

Closing date 16th September 2019 (Unless all places taken before this date)

(Limited to 20 dogs and handlers) **Cost £25.00 per 4 runs**

We are offering the opportunity to train your dog in a show environment. The venue will be set up to look like a regular licensed Kennel Club show. Each participant will have four opportunities during the day to work their dog in the ring for a maximum of four minutes each time.

- You will be able to utilise this time in whatever way you wish.
- Toys and food are allowed in the ring all day. *(Please consider others and avoid using food that breaks up all over the floor)*

Participating dogs:

1. Do not have to be registered with the Kennel Club to participate, however they must be over ten months on the day of the show. Dogs under 18 months on the day of the show must not perform excessive freestyle moves and judges reserve the right to stop a routine if the dog is performing moves inappropriate to its age.
2. No bitch in season is allowed at the venue.
3. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that their dog is healthy and fit to participate.
4. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling in the precincts of the show.
5. No moves or handling which may cause injury to the dog are allowed.
6. All dogs must be under control within in the precincts of the show at all times.
7. Anyone not adhering to the above rules will be asked to leave the venue.

Entering the show:

- Each handler will have four opportunities to work in the ring. You may work the same dog each time or split their turns between two or more dogs.
- **Please complete the entry form accurately;** we will however aim to be flexible on the day if at all possible. *(NB. The order that you fill in the entry form will be the order that your dogs will work)*
- For music licensing purposes you are required to fill in the title and performer of the music you wish to use for each round. *(Please avoid putting "To be advised/confirmed")*
- **NOTE: Music - Only 1 track of a CD will be played each run, therefore if you want a full 4 Mins in the ring you must supply an edited track of 4 minutes and NOT expect the DJ to replay the track up to 4 mins.**
- There will be a running order on the day for each class.
- Your running orders will be available at the booking in table on arrival.
- Please arrive for the start of the classes. We appreciate you arriving early to make sure we can provide all dogs/handlers with an audience and make it a more realistic show environment for those taking part in the early rounds.

On the day:

- You will receive your running order and feedback sheets at the book in table. Please complete your feedback sheets as soon as you can and put them in the correct class box. (and in your running order envelope)
- Due to handlers using the same music several times throughout the day, please book in your music for your first 2 runs.
- Please remember to collect your music from the DJ upon exiting from the ring, then if using the same music again, place it in the correct envelope on the booking in table ready for your next class.
- **CD's only please**, marked with correct track. On occasion CD's burned on computers don't always work on CD players therefore please test your CD before you arrive.
- Your rounds will be watched by an experienced HTM competitor/judge who will provide written feedback, if requested, which will be available immediately after leaving the ring, and can be taken away at the end of the day. **Please be as specific as possible when asking for feedback.**
 - **Please note:** If you decide you do not require feedback or would like the judge to video your round instead please note this on your feedback sheet. (*For videoing you will need to provide your own camera*)
- When you are not working your dog, we would appreciate it if you would remain in the venue where possible as an audience for the other participants to simulate a real show atmosphere.
- **The show will open at 8:30am for a 9.00am prompt start.**

Ring Size is approximately: 11m x 15m and the ring area will be carpeted

About the Venue:

It is a showground and there may be other events on at the same time. There are plenty of places to walk your dog(s) however, please keep your dog(s) on lead around the car-parking and camping areas.

Please note: Although the venue is indoors it is not heated therefore we suggest bringing layers to ensure you are comfortable.

Catering: Tea / Coffee and snacks will be available on the day however please bring your own lunch.

***Don't forget to PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG(S) – Thank you**
